Dear Mr. [REDACTED]:

This correspondence is in response to your letter requesting information related to vehicle operation requirements in the State of Nevada.

Nevada will recognize and honor a registration from another state. However, if the vehicle will be continuously operated in Nevada for a period exceeding 30-days, the vehicle must be registered in this State. Requirements for registering a vehicle in Nevada include:

- Most recent registration certificate
- Out-of-State license plates
- Nevada Emissions Vehicle Inspection Report (in Clark and Washoe counties)
- Nevada Vehicle Inspection Certification (completed at a DMV office)
- Certificate of Ownership (if ownership is changing)
- Liability insurance from a Nevada licensed agent in the exact name(s), which will be on the new registration. Out-of-State insurance is not acceptable.

Nevada does recognize a Japanese driver's license. In the absence of a Japanese driver's license, an International Driving Permit will be required.
